- A member of PMBC Church and an active PMBC Youth Ministry Participant
- Have admission to and commitment to attend or currently attending an accredited four-year college in the United States as a candidate for a degree.
- Have a demonstrated commitment to community service.
- 2.5 GPA Minimum

Additional requirements for the four available scholarships below may include:

- Essay (as described the respective scholarship)
- Two letters of Recommendation (one from a counselor, one from a teacher)
- Official high school record or college transcript with official seal and/or signature
- Official copy of SAT scores
- Letter of acceptance from college of choice or confirmation of college enrollment
- Financial and award letter from college of choice
- Full cost of attending college, room and board, travel, book
- 2.75 GPA Minimum
- Have an economic need for financial assistance and a family income of less than \$70,000 or if income is greater, a request to waive the limit for good cause.
- Proof of income the first page of the most recent IRS 1040 form of parents or guardian with whom you live and/or who financially supports you and a copy of your Financial Aid
- Demonstrate Financial Need
- Must be a male graduate of Atlanta's John F. Kennedy Middle School.

Selection Criteria

Selection Criteria

- Open to all high school juniors and seniors who are members, or otherwise significantly affiliated with, Providence Missionary Baptist Church.
- Annually, one female student and one male student will be selected for the award.
- Applicants must have demonstrated significant achievement and promise in an artistic field, including but not limited to the visual arts, painting, sculpting, photography, film, acting, dance, writing, or poetry.
- Applicants must have demonstrated significant and impactful community service over a substantial period of time.
- Applicants will be judged based upon their submission of an essay which describes their artistic aspirations and commitment to lifelong community service.
- The winners of the award will be presented with a cash prize in an amount to be determined on an annual basis.
